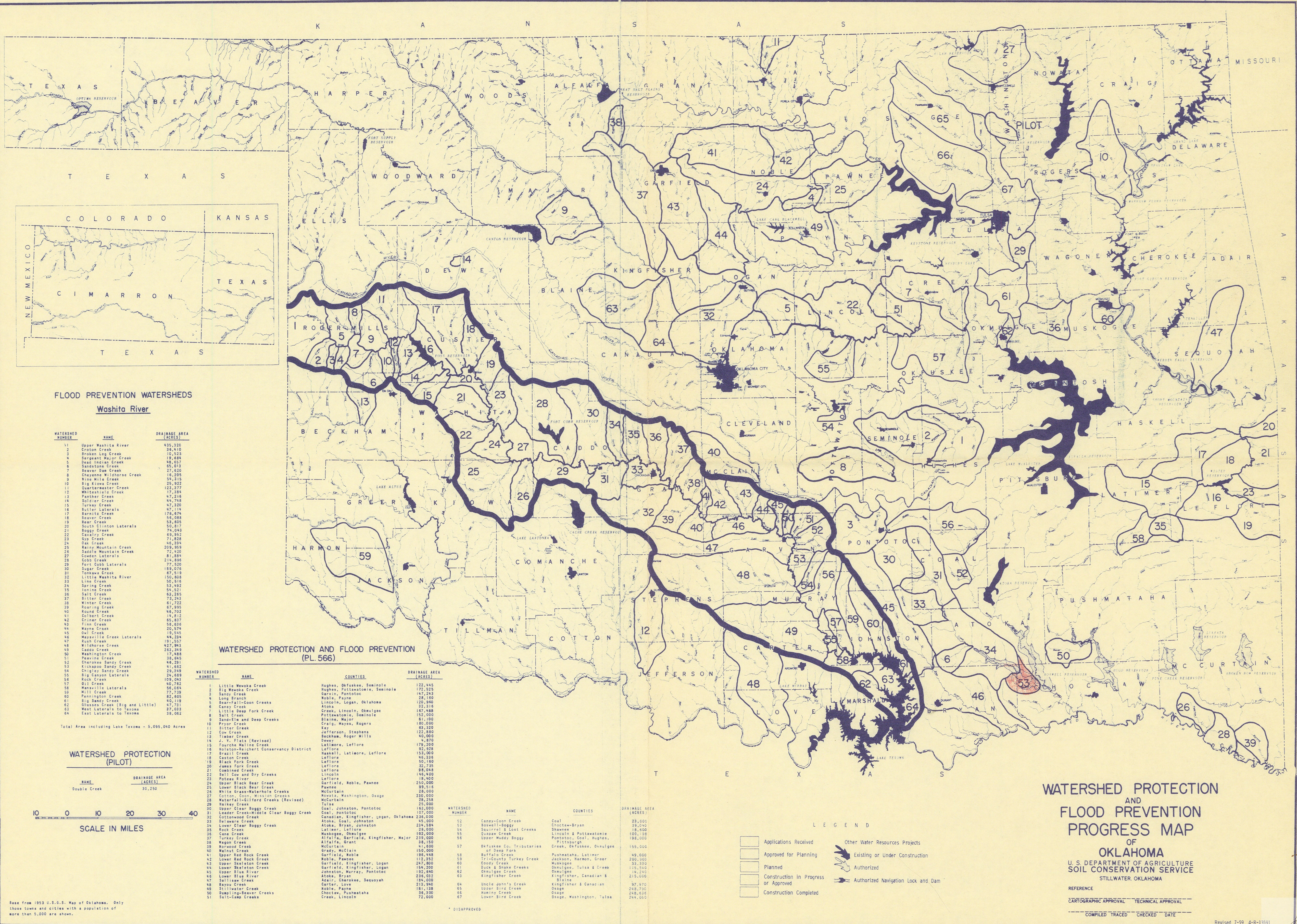

WATERSHED PROTECTION AND FLOOD PREVENTION PROGRESS MAP OF OKLAHOMA

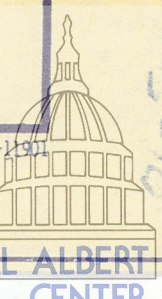
