

WASHINGTON--Rep. Carl Albert announced today that his 1963 appointee to the U. S. Air Force Academy will be Douglas Lee Brazil, son of Lt. Col. and Mrs. Virgil L. Brazil and grandson of Mrs. Edna Neely, all of Hartshorne.

Brazil made the highest score on the competitive examination given by the U. S. Air Force to nine outstanding young men from throughout the Third Congressional district nominated by Albert. The Third District Congressman has been advised by the Air Force that Brazil has qualified for the appointment and will enter the Air Force Academy at Colorado Springs, Colo., in June.

Brazil, whose parents are graduates of Hartshorne High School, was graduated last June from the Nelson C. Brown Dependents school in Morocco, where his father is stationed with the Air Force. His record at the school was outstanding both scholastically and in extracurricular activities. He served as president of the Student Council, the junior toastmasters' club, the Teen club, the junior class and the school chess club. He lettered in track, football, basketball and tennis.
