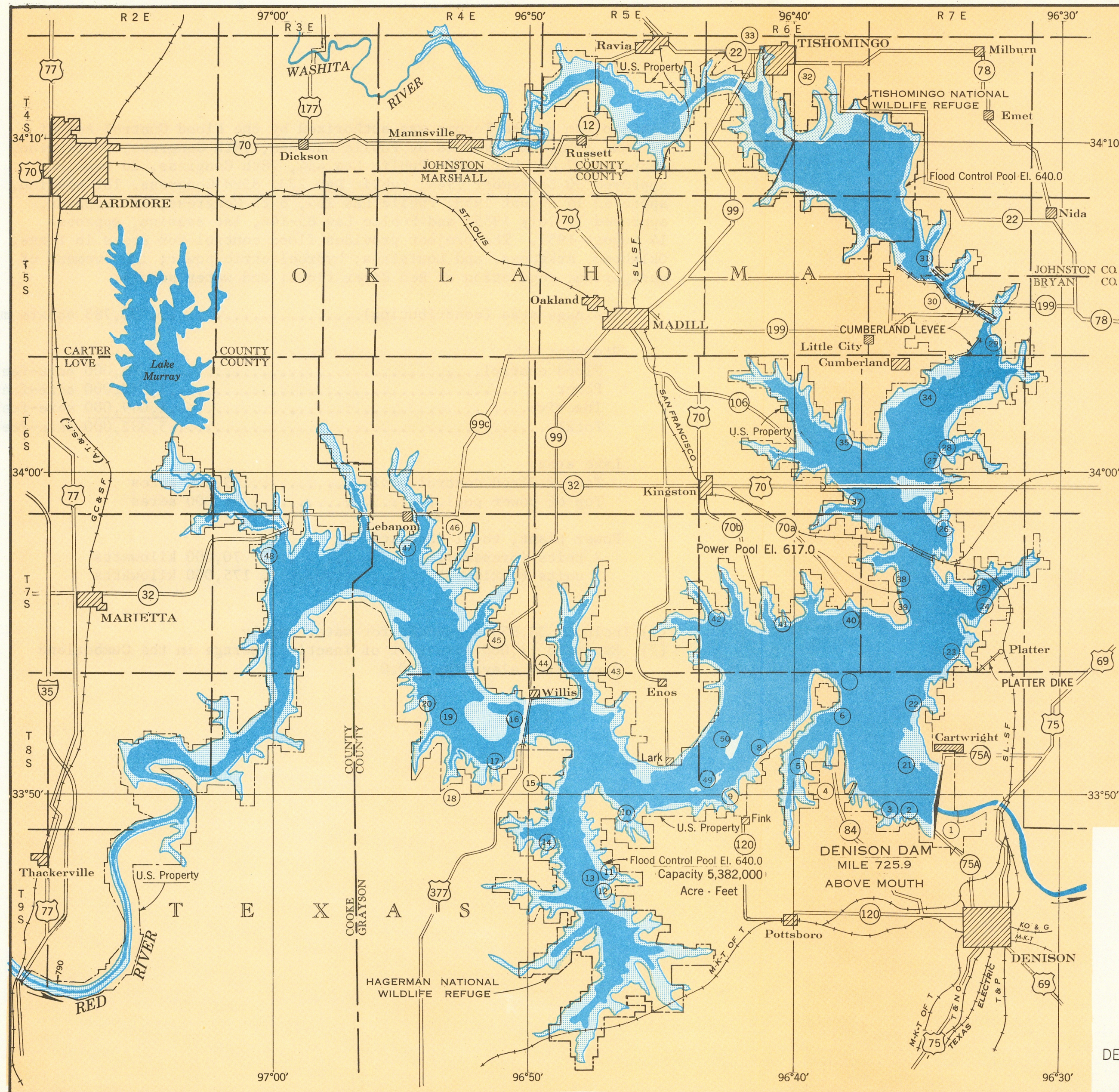


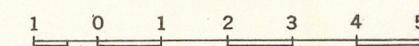

Denison Dam - Lake Texoma was authorized by the Flood Control Act of 28 June 1938, and amended by Public Law 868, 76th Congress, 3d session, approved 17 October 1940; Public Law 454, 78th Congress, 2d session, approved 30 September 1944; Public Law 273, 83rd Congress, 1st session, approved 14 August 1953; Public Law 164, 84th Congress, 1st session, approved 15 July 1955; and Public Law 85-146, 1st session, approved 14 August 1957. The project provides flood control for areas in Texas, Oklahoma, Arkansas, and Louisiana; hydroelectric power; improvement of navigation; regulation of Red River flows; and water supply.

Lake area:

2 units (present)..... 70,000 kilowatts
