Dear Friend:

I have your letter of the 4th instant relative to certain claims which you say the Delaware Indians have pending before the U. S. Court of Claims. There are so many Indian claims pending in one form or another, that I have not had time to go into them. As a matter of fact, I am a Member of the Committee on Indian Affairs, and we are kept quite busy there passing upon various claims and legislation submitted to our Committee.

If you have a claim pending before the U.S. Court of Claim, your group is bound to be represented by someone as attorney; and I suggest that you ask your attorney to advise you on this subject. I have practiced law for more than thirty-five years and I know something about how intricate and complex these questions are. It would doubtless require several weeks concentrated study to determine just what has been done and is being done with reference to your claim, since I know nothing about it now. On the other hand, your attorney has had the benefit of long study and personal touch with your claim, and should be able to tell you exactly what the status of it is. Furthermore, I don't know the number of your claim, its style, nor the basis of the claim. Hence, it is very difficult to locate these claims without further information.

I wish I could do more for you, but I really think you should confer with your attorney and then if there is anything he wants me to do I shall be very glad to have him make his request, and it will be a pleasure for me to look into the question for the benefit of all concerned.
