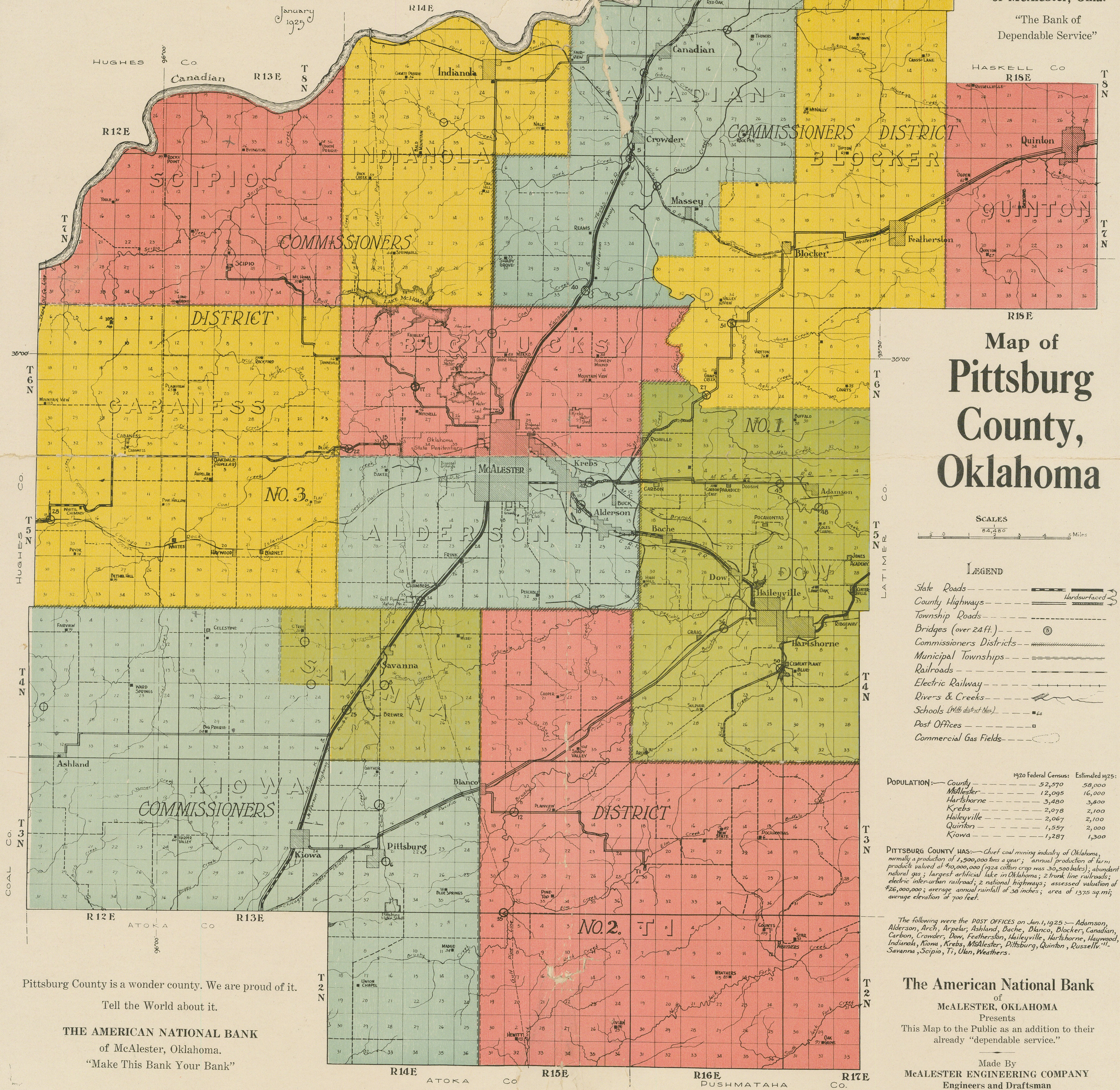

PITTSBURG COUNTY HAS: — Chief coal mining industry of Oklahoma; normally a production of 1,500,000 tons a year; annual production of farm products valued at \$40,000,000 (1924 cotton crop was 30,500 bales); abundant natural gas; largest artificial lake in Oklahoma; 2 trunk line railroads; electric inter-urban railroad; 2 national highways; assessed valuation of \$26,000,000; average annual rainfall of 38 inches; area of 1375 sq. mi.; average elevation of 700 feet.
